• Microplastics in the Environment:

 The Commission launched a call for evidence on <u>microplastics pollution – measures to reduce its</u> <u>impact on the environment of unintentionally released</u> <u>microplastics from tyres, textiles and plastic pellets</u> in order to prepare the impact assessment of this future legislative initiative.

• Critical raw materials: action plan:

 A Council official indicated the upcoming French Council Presidency could decide to propose Conclusions in response to the action plan.

• State Aid guidelines:

 The European Commission issued a <u>Communication</u> on 24 November 2021 supplementing the Guidelines on certain State aid measures in the context of the system for greenhouse gas emission allowance trading post-2021.
