- Basel Convention:
  - The co-chairs of the <u>EWG on the RA</u> (Experts Working Group on the revision) have invited members and observers to provide <u>written feedback</u> on the possible amendments of Annexes I (Categories of waste to be controlled) and III (List of hazardous characteristics) of the Basel Convention by 28 February 2022.
  - Please provide us with any comments by 15 February 2022, COB.
- Draft standardisation request on recycled plastics and plastics recycling:
  - The European Commission Commission transmitted to the European Standardisation Bodies (CEN, Cenelec and ETSI)

# Monitoring of EU Institutions

### Life of EU institutions

- <u>Sewage Sludge Directive:</u>
  - New EU rules updating the questionnaire for reporting on the Sewage Sludge Directive entered into force.
- Single Use Plastic (beverage bottles and tobacco products):
  - Commission's new rules on the reporting format of data and information concerning post-consumption waste tobacco products with filters and filters marketed for use in combination with tobacco products entered into force.
- New Regulatory Framework for Batteries:
  - The vote in the ENVI Committee is envisaged on 10 February (instead of the 26 January). The Plenary session is scheduled for the first session in March.
  - The ENVI Committee is expected to maintain the Commission's original proposal of mandatory recycled content (Article 8).
- <u>Waste Shipment Regulation:</u>
  - The ENVI Committee appointed MEP Pernille Weiss as the Committee's Rapporteur responsible for preparing the draft Report on the proposal revising the Waste Shipment Regulation.
- Single Use Plastics (cups for beverages and food containers):
  - Member States experts voted for the draft
    Commission Implementing Decision laying down the

methodology for calculation and verification of consumption reduction of plastic cups and their lids and food containers.

- Draft report of Rapporteur (ENVI) Peter Liese on EU ETS:
  - Proposes to include municipal waste incineration in the EU
    ETS as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2028.
- <u>CARACAL:</u>

• Industrial Emissions Directive (IED):

FEAD participated on the 16<sup>th</sup> IED Article 13 Forum meeting held on 17 December 2021. The work members discussed about the forum opinion on the final draft BAT reference document for the ferrous metals processing industry, the revision of the IED and E-PRTR Regulation. The EIPPCB updated the Forum members on its work programme 2022 and presented the planed upgrade of the BAT Information System.
